Revision Background



- The Central Committee of the CPC and the State Council attach great importance to strengthening anti-monopoly and preventing disorderly expansion of capital.
- The Anti-Monopoly Law has played an important role since its implementation in 2008.
- With China's economic and social development, some articles do not meet the requirement of high-quality development.



Revision Process



- The State Administration for Market Regulation has drafted the "Anti-Monopoly Law of the People's Republic of China (draft revision for review)" and made it available to the public for comments.
- The Ministry of Justice consulted with relevant departments, provincial governments and some industrial associations and enterprises, and after repeated revisions and improvements, formed the Anti-Monopoly Law of the People's Republic of China (draft amendment).
- The draft has been approved by the State Council.



The General Idea of the Revision



- Deeply implementing the decision-making arrangements of the Central Committee of the CPC and the State Council.
- Adhering to problem-orientation and goal-orientation, in view of the outstanding problems in the implementation of the anti-monopoly law, further improving the anti-monopoly-related systems, and increasing the penalties for monopolistic acts.
- While improving the basic systems and rules, leaving room for the development of anti-monopoly guidelines and other supporting provisions.



Main Content of the Revision



- The revision clarified the foundational position of the competition policies and the legal position of the fair competition review system.
- Further improved the anti-monopoly-related systems and rules.
- Further ensured the implementation of anti-monopoly enforcement.
- Improved legal liability rules and increased the intensity of penalties.
